



UPDATED FACE MASK REGULATIONS

Recently the Center for Disease Control updated its Mask Wearing Guidelines and shortly thereafter so did the State of Illinois as we moved into the Bridge Phase of the Restore Illinois Plan. This includes Governor Pritzker releasing Executive Order 2021-10 officially addressing Bridge Phase guidance and the easing of mask and social distancing requirements for fully vaccinated individuals. Around the same time, the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity provided updated guidance for certain Illinois industries. Taking all this into account and analyzing the activities and functions of the Wood Dale Park District, the following updated face mask regulations are now in effect in and at all park district facilities.

OUTDOOR FACILITIES AND PROGRAMS

- Fully vaccinated individuals are not required to wear a facemask or social distance.
- Individuals NOT fully vaccinated are encouraged to wear a facemask when social distancing.

INDOOR FACILITIES AND PROGRAMS

- Fully Vaccinated Individuals are not required to wear a mask or social distance during classes or while engaging in activities (unless participating with individuals under 12 years of age).
- Individuals NOT fully vaccinated should continue to wear a mask and social distance in classes and while engaging in activities.
- Youth Sports, Summer Camps and Youth Programs will continue to follow DCEO Guidance which currently requires face masks.
- ALL Individuals are REQUIRED to wear a mask in COMMON areas including entries/exits, lobbies, locker rooms, restrooms, spectator areas and hallways.

BY PARTICIPATING IN A PARK DISTRICT PROGRAM or IN ALLOWED AREAS WITHOUT A FACE MASK YOU ARE VERIFYING THAT YOU ARE FULLY VACCINATED.

YOU ARE CONSIDERED FULLY VACCINATED:

- Two weeks after a 2-dose or single dose vaccine.

If you do not meet these requirements, regardless of your age, you are NOT fully vaccinated. Keep taking precautions until you are FULLY VACCINATED.
